Notice

If the applicant fails to attend the following procedures and schedules because applicants has not personally checked schedule and results, institute will not be responsible.
2. There is a concern about system failure due to simultaneous access during the deadline for application, you can apply smoothly if you apply in advance before the deadline.

Tuition fee



- Confirmation of payment is based on the amount above in KRW regardless of exchange rate.(Students should pay for all the bank charges)
- D-4 visa applicants should pay for 2 or 4 semesters(a year) of tuition fee at once in advance.(vary depending on countries)
- Foreign students who have stayed in Korea for 6 months as of the date of entry will automatically sign up as Korea National Health Insurance. 6 months prior, individual enrollment in international student medical insurance.
